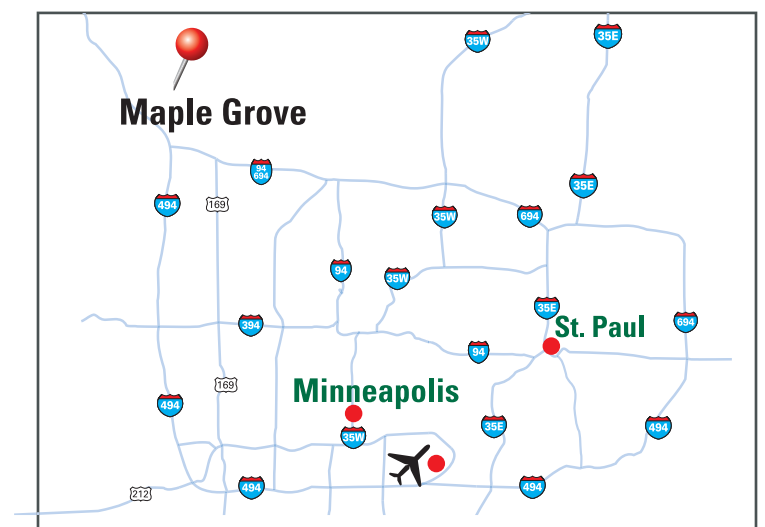

SNOW TUBING & CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING AT

Elm Creek Park Preserve

Glide through the snow with two of Minnesota's favorite winter activities – snow tubing and cross-country skiing. Elm Creek Park Reserve is one of most expansive winter recreation areas in the Twin Cities and is known for winter fun and beauty. These activities are designed for whichever "speed" you like. For those who want to go fast, snow tubing is just the thing. You'll ride a moving sidewalk up a hill 10-stories high and soar back down on a specially designed inner tube. There are steeper chutes for the more daring and easier chutes for those looking for a more laid-back ride. All are designed for safety and fun. For those looking something a little slower, try cross-country skiing. You'll receive a 2-hour ski lesson where you can explore some beautiful, groomed trails throughout the park. The serene trails will offer winter solitude and possible wildlife sightings. A blend of modern and rustic, the warm and inviting Elm Creek Chalet is a beautiful facility for your event. The building features a huge stone fireplace built of timbers and fieldstone, a cathedral-style ceiling, and large glass windows overlooking Elm Creek Park Reserve.

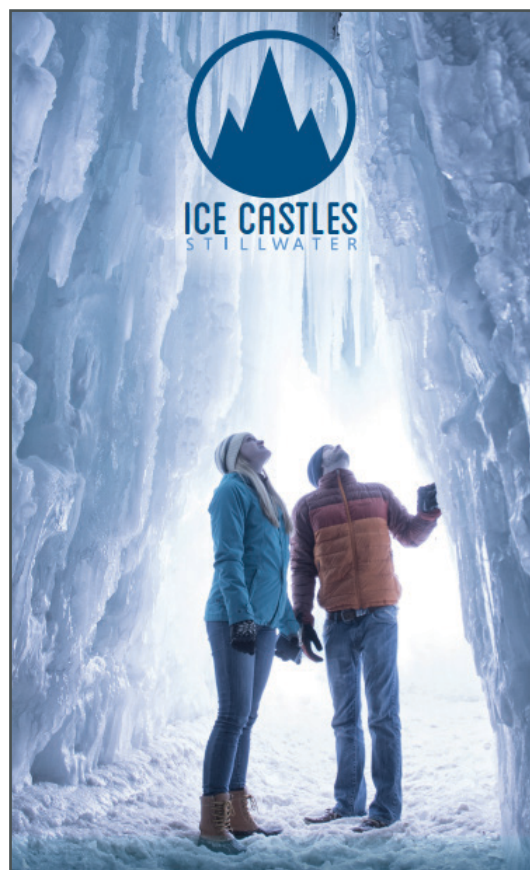


SIGHTSEEING IN PICTURESQUE SMALL TOWN ALONG THE ST. CROIX RIVER

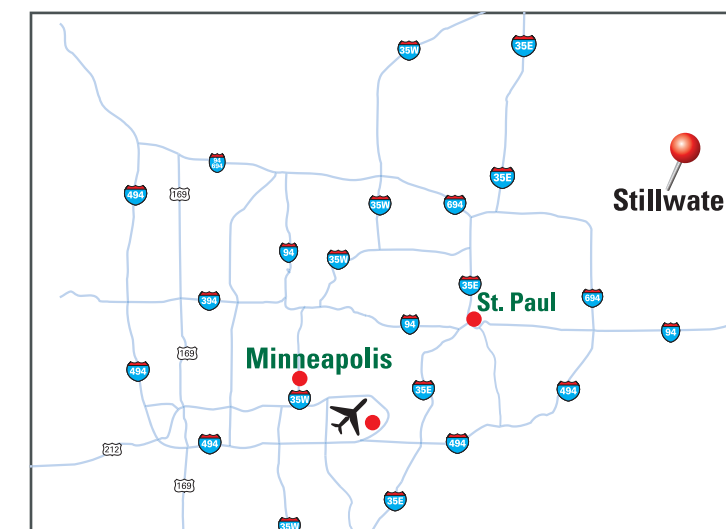

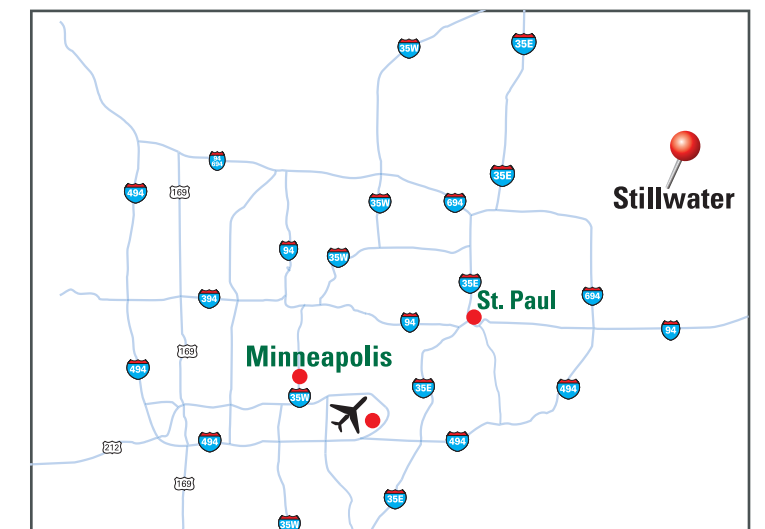

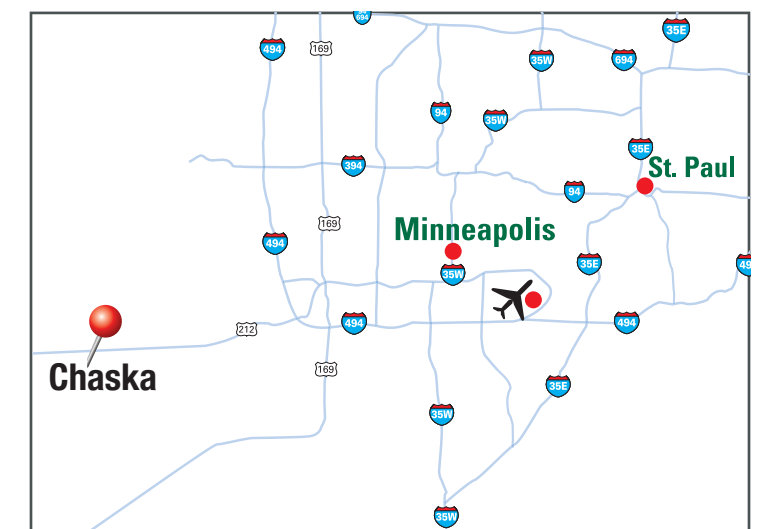
